Asphalt Rules

1. Stock 1-10,000 pounds
2. Limited Open Light 1-5500 pounds
3. Limited Open Heavy 5501-10,000 pounds Classes

General Rules

1. Contestants enter at their own risk. County Line Antique Tractor Club it members or sponsors shall not be held liable or responsible for any accidents, injuries or damage cause in connection with tractor pulls.
2. All tractors and operators must weigh in before the pull. Contestants must sign a waiver at time of weigh in. Any contestant under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the waiver also. An adult responsible for the underage contestant must be at track side during the pull while minors are pulling. No one is allowed on the pulling track during the pull except track workers.
3. Each puller will be allowed two attempts to make a full pull at each weight on the sled. Two revolutions of tire spin shall be considered one attempt.
4. All pulls shall be from a tight chain, no jerking allowed. If puller is called for a jerk they forfeit that attempt, if jerk occurs on second attempt it shall be considered a spin out. If a puller is called for a second jerk with the same tractor in a class that puller will be disqualified.
5. The driver shall have the option of direction of pull on a second attempt. When the back of the boat passes the out of bounds line for the end of the track the boat will be spotted to the center of the pulling track and the next pull will be in the direction of the spot pull unless it is a second attempt.
6. Excessive RMP shall not be allowed, excessive oil or water leaks shall not be allowed.
7. Drivers must remain seated while pulling, there will be no bouncing on the seat and at least one hand on the steering wheel, hand clutch or hand brake at all time.
8. Wheelie bars are mandatory, they must be independent of the hitch at least 4" behind the radius of the tires, no higher than 16" off the ground and no closer than 20" together, must have a minimum of 4" x 4" pads and be able to support the tractor at its heaviest weight.
9. Drawbar must be no higher than 18", hitch point can be no closer than 24" from the center of the rear axle, or behind the radius of the tires. No vertical clevis's allowed and hitch shall be rigid in all directions. No chains or cables shall be used to support or restrain the hitch. Tractors may pull in the stock class without wheelie bars if the hitch is no higher than 16" and hitch extends behind the radius of the rear tires a minimum of 2".

10. If any parts or weights fall off tractor while pulling the tractor will be disqualified for that class.
11. All pulls are calculated on a percentage of the tractor weight.
12. Entry fee will be \$15 for each class and weight.
13. Only one trophy per tractor per class.
14. Pull officials must check hitch and wheelie bars before pull, No adding of fuel after weigh in.
15. Driver must weigh in tractor after spin out and before adding weight if pulling more than one class. Tractor shall not receive and percentage while taking bye if pulling more than one weight or driver.
16. Judges shall stop any contestant operating in an unsafe or dangerous manner. Judges have final say on all rules and any situations that arise.

Stock Class Rules

1. All farm tractor eligible for this class regardless of the year produced.
2. All stock tractors must have Ag style rubber tires no larger than one size over factory option, burden of proof on tire size is contestants responsibility, no dual tires allowed.
3. All weights must be securely fastened to the tractor and shall not extend more than 36" behind the center of the rear axle and no further forward than the radius of the front tires.

Limited Open Classes

1. All farm tractors eligible for this class regardless of year produced or tire size on tractor. No duals allowed.
2. All weights must be securely fastened and shall not extend more than 36" behind the center of the rear axle or extend more than 11' forward from the center of the rear axle.
