Steel Wheel Pull Rules
Revised 2/2/17

1. All tractors and operators must weigh in before the pull. Contestants must sign a waiver at the time of weigh in. Any contestant under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the waiver also. Parent or guardian of the minor must remain at track side during the pull. No one is allowed on the track except puller and track workers.
2. Hitch will be no higher than 16" with spades in the ground. Hitch must be behind the radius of the wheel face if the tractor does not have wheelie bars. If tractor has wheelie bars, hitch can be no less than 18" from the center of the rear axle to the hook point and no higher than 16" with spades in the ground. Wheelie bars must be behind the radius of the wheel, strong enough to support the weight of the tractor, pads hit the ground before hook and be independent of the hitch.
3. Weights must not extend more than 36" back from the center of the rear axle and not more than 11' forward from the center of the rear axle. No weights shall interfere with hooking or un-hooking the tractor.
