## TRANSFER SLED GENERAL RULES

1. All pullers must be 18 years old or have a parent or legal guardian sign them in. All rules and unforeseen issues are subject to judge's discretion
2. All tractor and operators must weigh in before the pull. Contestants must sign waiver at time of weigh in. Any contestant under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the waiver also. An adult responsible for the underage contestant must be at track side during the pull while minors are pulling. No one is allowed on the pulling track during the pull except track workers.
3. Wheelie bars are required for 5 mph and open class. Recommended for 3 mph. One hand must remain on the steering the steering wheel at all times or both hands on a combination of hand brake, hand clutch or throttle at all times.
4. If the rear tire of the tractor touches the out of bounds line the puller will be disqualified. If any weights or parts fall off the tractor it will be disqualified.
5. No excessive RPM's.
6. Pullers in 3 mph and 5 mph cannot beep the horn after the speed cone.
7. Pullers may not protest another tractor after it leaves the track. Judges may check any tractor at any time.
8. No dual tires or chains. 4x4 tractors allowed but must have 4x4 disengaged while pulling.
9. Weights cannot extend more than 11' from the center of the rear axle forward, and cannot be behind the radius of the rear tire or 36" behind the center of the rear axle; whichever is further. Weights must not interfere with hooking and un-hooking of tractor.

## **3 mph class rules**

1. Speed limit is 3 mph. No beeps allowed after speed cone.
2. Tire size is 0-5000 lbs 15.5 x 38. 18.4 for 33" and smaller rims. 5001 and up is unlimited. Top cut tires only.
3. Hitches must be rigid in all directions and no more than 19" high. If tractor does not have wheelie bars hook point of hitch must be behind the radius of the tire. If tractor has wheelie bars hitch can be no closer than 18" from the center of the rear axle to the hook point. Hook must swing freely in hook hole. Wheelie bars must be behind the radius of the tire, able to support the weight of the tractor, pads must hit before hook and bars must be independent of the hitch.

## **5 mph class rules**

1. Speed limit is 5 mph. No beeps allowed after speed cone.
2. All tractors must have a working kill switch.
3. Hitch must be ridged in all directions, no higher than 19" and no less than 18" from the center of the axle to the hook point. Hook must swing freely in hook hole.
4. Tire size is unlimited. Full cut tires allowed.
5. Fenders and wheelie bars are required. Wheelie bars must be behind the tires and strong enough to support the weight of the tractor. Pads must hit before the hook does. Bars must be independent of the hitch.

## **8 mph class rules**

1. Speed limit is 8 mph. No beeps allowed after speed cone.
2. All tractors must have a working kill switch.
3. Hitch must be ridged in all directions, no higher than 19". And no less than 18" from the center of the axle to the hook point. Hook must swing freely in the hook hole.
4. Tire size is unlimited. Full cut tires allowed.
5. Fenders and wheelie bars are required. Wheelie bars must be behind the tires and strong enough to support the weight of the tractor. Pads must hit before the hook does. Bars must be independent of the hitch.

## **Open class rules**

1. No speed limit.
2. All tractors must have a working kill switch.
3. Hitch must be ridged in all directions, no higher than 19" and no less than 18" from the center of the axle to the hook point. Hook must swing freely in hook hole.
4. Tire size is unlimited. Full cut tires allowed.
5. Fenders and wheelie bars are required. Wheelie bars must be behind the tires and strong enough to support the weight of the tractor. Pads must hit before the hook does. Bars must be independent of the hitch.
